

GUIDELINES FOR ALIENATION OF PROPERTY

- 1. In order to ensure that future owners are bound by the same conditions that were binding on original buyers, the title deed of the properties on the estate contains a condition that consent must be given by the Fernkloof Estate Master Property Owners Association, before transfer can take place.
- 2. In order to obtain the consent, the following criteria must be met:
 - The levy account must be up to date
 - The transferring attorney must undertake to pay the endowment levy upon transfer (0.25% of the selling price)
 - The new owner must sign an undertaking that he will abide by the constitution of the MPOA and the Precinct, and other rules made in support of these documents.
- 3. The new owner must sign a debit order instruction to facilitate the regular collection of monthly levies (also a condition of transfer).
- 4. All of the above will be requested by the transferring attorney before lodging for transfer.
- 5. All sales of erven (even from an owner to e.g. a trust formed by the owner) are subject to the above procedure.
